Dear Plan Participants and Beneficiaries:

This is a summary of the annual report for IBEW Local No. 461 Defined Contribution Pension Plan, EIN: 36-2882653, Plan No. 001, for the period of January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Benefits under the plan are provided through insurance and/or annuity contracts and by the trust fund. Plan expenses were \$5,101,959. These expenses included \$200,862 in administrative and operating expenses, and \$4,901,097 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 1,040 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$153,559,134 as of December 31, 2023, compared to \$128,327,745 as of January 1, 2023. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$25,231,389. This increase includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$30,333,348, including employer contributions of \$7,978,078, losses of \$5,874,524 from the sale of assets, and earnings from investments of \$28,229,794.

MINIMUM FUNDING STANDARDS

Enough money was contributed to the plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.

- 5. Insurance information including sales commissions paid by insurance carriers; and
- 6. Information regarding any common or collective trusts, pooled separate accounts, master trusts or 103-12 investment entities in which the plan participates, and

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan (Board of Trustees of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local Union 461 Defined Contribution Pension Plan, 6525 Centurion Drive, Lansing, MI 48917) and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
